# **Posting of Public School Governing Authority Fiscal Information**

<u>2023 Act 370</u> by Sen. Rick Emonds imposed new school budget transparency requirements for all public schools, including charter schools. In addition to the budget requirements set forth in <u>17:3996(G)</u>, <u>17:88</u>, and <u>39:1301-1315</u>, Act 370 requires the following:

### Requirements applicable this 2023-24 school year and beyond:

- Budget and general summary must be posted on the website no later than September 30th
- Annual audit must be posted on the website within 30 days of approval and acceptance by the legislative auditor

### Requirements applicable beginning July 1, 2024 and beyond:

Charter school boards will be required to post the following on its website.

- Semi-annual reports detailing actual revenue, receipts, expenditures, and disbursements
- Reports will include contracts for each quarter to include the identity of the vendor, the purpose of the contract, and payments associated with each contract.
- Contracts are defined as ANY type of agreement, including
  - Orders, grants and documents representing grants which are for the purchase or disposal of supplies, services, major repairs, or any other item.
  - Applicable awards and notices of awards
  - Contracts of a fixed price, cost, cost-plus-a-fixed-fee, or incentive types
  - Contracts providing for the issuance of a job or task order
  - Leases
  - Letter contracts
  - Purchase orders
  - Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)
  - Cooperative Endeavor Agreements (CEA)
  - Personal, professional, consulting, and social service contracts.

### Required Reporting Schedule

- The report for July December must be posted no later than March 31st.
- The report for January through June must be posted no later than September 30th.
- Reports must be submitted to the Louisiana Department of the Treasury. Deadlines have not yet been posted.

## Required Reporting Format

• The Louisiana Department of Education is working with a focus group that includes charter school business managers to develop a reporting format. The expected release is in early June 2024.

• Budget reports will be revised to match annual financial reports (AFR). The same data will be captured, but will be reported by function, rather than object code.
